## General Information

### **Saturday and Sunday Activities**

All activities will be running from 10-5 on Saturday and Sunday and groups will be able to try these when they wish.

### **Health Forms**

As always, please ensure each visitor has completed a health form (attached & see Frylands' Website, Downloads section, for Scout Med version) but please bring an extra copy of all your Group's health forms in a sealed envelope. The copies will be given to Scout Med (see below), used in case of an emergency and shredded after the event. You should keep a copy of the form with your Group at your site.

### **Rifle Shooting Permission**

Please find enclosed a Permission to Shoot form which all visitors under the age of 18 must get their parents/guardians to sign.

### **Parking Permits and Arrival**

Parking will be on Pear Tree Farm which is also on Featherbed Lane, a few hundred yards South East of Frylands. The Frylands Wood car park will be reserved for Crew and any visitors with disabilities. Please let us know in advance if you need a space in the Frylands car park and we will send you a specific permit.

We request that you try to arrange to meet your Group at your HQ and travel to Frylands in the least number of vehicles to reduce congestion. If you cannot meet at your HQ first, please arrange to arrive at Frylands at a specific time (sorry to state the obvious but makes it easier for us!). Groups should not arrive before 4pm but if you want to setup up camp before 4pm (or the day before) please let us know.

Your kit will be transferred to your site by one of our Scout 4x4 vehicles and trailer (unless you want to carry your kit to your site). Pedestrians will be initially directed along Bunny Drive to avoid vehicle routes. Please meet the 4x4 at your site as soon as possible so the 4x4 can empty quickly and go and collect the next Group's kit from Pear Tree Farm. If you've arrived to setup early, please meet your young people in the Car Park at your arranged time.

### **Emergency Evacuation Procedure**

Please read and distribute the enclosed Emergency Evacuation Procedure to all your leaders.

### **Booking in**

Within an hour of arrival, please send one leader to the Site Office in the Frylands Car Park to book in and pay any remaining balances, collect wrist bands, event details, tickets for the BBQ and maps.

### **Day Visitors**

Day visitors should come to the Frylands car park where you will be allowed to park for the day if there are spaces available. If the car park is full you will have to park in Pear Tree Farm. If some of your group are staying for the weekend they will have your wrist bands and passports. If not, please send one leader to check in as described above.

### **Security and Wrist bands**

Everyone on the Site will have to wear a wrist band. We will have a Security Team patrolling the event and anyone who hasn't got one will be challenged. If you see anyone without a wrist band please report it to a nearest member of Crew or Security.

### **Fires**

With the exception of Farleigh Field, all campsites should have an existing fire pit. Please use this wherever possible taking extra consideration of the number of tents that may be on your site. If you are on Farleigh Field please request an altar fire from the Site Office. Please note that there is plenty of dead wood around the site. There is no need to use green wood. At the end of your stay please scatter the ashes and leave any remaining wood in a neat pile.

### **Badges**

Each participant will receive a badge which will be sent to you after the event.

### **Saturday Evening Meal**

On arrival you will be given tickets for a jacket potato with filling and for a donut afterwards. Due to the large number of people we have to serve, you will be allocated a half hour slot in which to collect your food. Please note that we have given earlier time slots to those Groups with younger members. Please bring the tickets and something to sit on to the Activity field. There will be free squash and water available and also cans for sale. Please leave the Activity Field once you have eaten ensuring that all litter is put in the bins provided.

### **First Aid**

Scout Med will be based between the main gate and the chapel. If a member has a simple cut or graze, please ask the qualified first aider in your group to deal with it. Please hand in the copies of each visitor's health form as described above to a member of the Scout Med team.

### **Consideration for other Campers**

There must be minimal noise between the hours of 23.00 and 07.00. If there is a group that you feel are not being considerate, please discuss it politely with them. If the problem persists contact a member of Security or Crew.

### **Litter**

At Frylands we recycle plastic bottles, glass, tins, paper and cardboard - this helps the environment and helps reduce our waste costs. You will find green recycling crates next to waste wheelie bins which will be dotted around Frylands and all of these will be emptied on a daily basis. Please contact a member of Crew to report an overflow. If possible, please bring your waste to the large wheelie bins next to the office. The red ones are for general waste and the black ones are for recycling.

## **Crew**

You can recognise a member of the Crew by their fluorescent waistcoats, yellow T shirts or Lanyards. If you have a general enquiry please go to the Site Office or Security Desk. Please note that all Crew are volunteers so please be polite and give them the respect they deserve. Without them, the event would not be able to go ahead.

## **Toilets**

Please ask your group to keep the toilets clean and tidy. Pick up any paper they drop, don't put any blue towels down the toilets and avoid splashing water. Please also kick off any loose mud from their shoes before they enter. The portable toilets dotted around the site are for use at night only. They will be locked during the day and they won't be emptied or cleaned for the whole weekend so it will be up to all campers to keep them clean and tidy. Extra toilet rolls are available - please visit the Site Office to request some. For over 18s there is a toilet block next to the climbing tower (it is a small pebble dashed building).

## **Pembroke One and Crew Hut**

These buildings will be used for sleeping and feeding Crew Members. If you have any queries please visit the Site Office or Security Desk rather than Pem 1 or Crew Hut as the Crew will probably be having a well earned meal or rest.

## **Providore - Tuck Shop**

The Providore will be open all day and evening until 9pm on Saturday and Sunday. You will be allocated a time slot for your Group but you are welcome to use the Providore at other times too.

## **Leaving your site as you found it**

On departure, we will expect the site to be left neat and tidy (see notes on fires above). If there are any problems with your site when you arrive please contact the site office immediately so we can try to resolve any problems. Please do a litter sweep before you leave. If your site is left untidy you will be asked to return to Frylands to tidy up.
